The Prustees shall be divided with respect to the time for which they shall severally hold office, into three classes, each consisting of one-thir of the whole number of the Board of Trustees as it may from time to time be constituted, unless the number of Prustees be not any multiple of three, in which case each class shall consist as nearly as possible of one-third of such number. The Pristees of the first class shall be elected for a term of one year; the trustees of the second class for a term of two years, and the trustees of the third class for a term of three years, and at each annual election the successors to the class of Prustees whose terms shall expire in that year shall be elected to hold office for the term of three years, so that the term of office for one class of Trustees shall expire in each year. The Trustees elected at the first annual meeting of the members shall classify themselves by lot into such classes.

In case of any increase in the number of Trustees, the additional Trustees shall be elected as may be provided by law or in the By-Laws, by the Trustees or by the members at an annual or special meeting, and the Trustees so elected shall be so distributed among the three classes that each class shall, as nearly as possible, constitute one-third of the whole number.




