

"Reverend James Caldwell Visits Town Named in his Honor"



The highlight of the evening will be a special dramatization by Reverend Richard Sommers and Ray Liptak. They will enact a visit from the *Reverend James Caldwell*, a Patriot during the American Revolutionary War, to the church that he founded and its present-day minister.

The Reverend James Caldwell, known as "the Fighting Parson of the Revolution," is most remembered by his actions at the Battle of Springfield, where he gave the soldiers pages from hymn books to use as wadding for their rifle bullets. He was hailed as one of the heroes of the day. Caldwell, NJ is named in his honor.
