## GROVER CLEVELAND GEOGRAPHY QUIZ

1. In Northern Yorkshire, England. Cleveland developed from “cliffsland”, the local name. There is also a Cleveland national forest in southern California given that name by president Teddy Roosevelt in honor of his friend grover. There are two more Cleveland mountains. One in Montana and one in Alaska.
2. Fayetteville, New York. Grover’s father served in several parishes in the region near the Erie canal. The Cleveland’s traveled from Caldwell to Fayetteville by wagon, Hudson river steam board and the Erie canal.
3. Hawaii. Cleveland invited the overthrown queen to the White House.
4. Chicago, Illinois. The exposition not only honored the memory of Christopher Columbus but also featured Buffalo Bill and the Wild West Show.
5. Cleveland was the hanging sheriff of Erie county, New York. He executed two men as part of the job.
6. Saint Louis, Missouri.
7. Venezuela.
8. Utah, on January 4, 1896. Cleveland was the end of his second term; most of the territories in the upper northwest were voted in by the republicans during the preceding term.
9. Massachusetts. The compound is on the cape cod canal and when sold later became a resort hotel.
10. Princeton, New Jersey. In his retirement, grover became a trustee of the local college.
11. Pullman, Illinois. May 11, 1894.
12. The Long Island sound. In the summer of 1893 during the greatest depression of the 19th c, he had a cancer removed from his jaw and part of the jaw itself, all done from the inside so his face would look the same; the mustache covered the area of the surgery. It was a big secret.
13. In the White House in the District of Columbia or Washington, d. C. The only bachelor president to e married in the white house.
14. The Capitol, Washington D. C. 1894. Coxey was pushed down the steps onto the grass and arrested for trespassing Coxey said, “ i appreciate as well as anyone else the fact that the preservation of the grass around the capitol is of more importance than saving thousands from starvation.”
15. New York. He rose from mayor of Buffalo to be governor to be president in just three years.
